

  - Spring 2023 – 898,598 (+7.2%)





## CCC Transfer Rates

- Those with stated transfer goal
  - 19% within four year
  - 28% within six years
- Latino students represent 51% of students but only 35% of those who transfer within 4 year
- African American students represent 7% of students but only 5% of those who transfer within 4 year

# Transfer Student Challenges



## Transfer Student Challenges

- Different UC and CSU lower division GE patterns
- Passive advising
  - Still using paper
  - CCCs articulate courses at transfer or graduation
- Students enroll at multiple CCCs
- Currently no common course numbering
- Some CCCs still enrolling students in remedial courses
